J de Villebois Sancerre Rosé 2023, Loire Valley. This offdry/semi-dry salmon-colored wine is a bit of an outlier: Mevushal and made from Pinot Noir in a region of the Loire better known for its bracing Sauvignon Blancs. This, however, is a sweeter-riper style, delivering the red fruits you'd find in baskets at the farmers market. Good pairing with soft cheeses, crab cakes and lobster rolls.
